Rosie Petal

Purpose of Petal:

When a Girl Scout earns this petal, she understands what it means to make the world a better place.

Supplies needed: Paper and supplies for drawing (i.e. crayons, markers, colored pencils)

Step 1: Learn what it means to “make the world a better place”.

*Optional: Log onto VTK or use the Daisy Guide to Girl Scouting to read Rosie’s story and talk about how Rosie showed that she wants to make the world a better place.

Open a conversation about what it means to make the world a better place. Encourage the girl(s) to think BIG, think LOCAL, and think about what can be done TODAY.

Step 2: Create and Share!

Have each girl draw a picture of one thing that she can do today to make the world a better place. She can then, share this picture with her troop, friends, and/or family!

Step 3: Practice making the world a better place!

Encourage the girls to TAKE ACTION and follow-through with their idea of how to make the world a better place TODAY! They can take pictures and/or share their efforts with others!

Congratulations! You have now earned the Rosie Petal!
