Badge Blueprint



Lupe Petal

Purpose: When a Girl Scout earns this petal, she understands what it means to be honest and fair, just like Lupe the Lupine.

Step 1: List and talk about Lupe's story

You can find Lupe's story at the Girl Scout Shop or in the Emerson Resource Center. Lupe's story is about doing what is right. When Lupe and her friends were trying to figure out what game to play, they each had a different idea. To make sure no one felt left out or didn't get their voice heard, Lupe suggested they play a game the group loved. While playing, a surprise gift came to the group from the Dairyland Farm. The gift was a box of cheese and was for everyone to share. Lupe was very hungry and thought for a moment about eating some without the group, but she decided that wasn't being honest or fair, so she did what was right and took it to the group for everyone to enjoy.

After you read the story, ask the girls "When did Lupe show she was honest and fair?" "How would Lupe's flower friends have felt if she had opened the gift of cheese without them and chose not to share it?" Now, ask the girls about a time they were honest and fair. How did they feel?

Step 2: Act out the story

Take the story and act it out! You can even have girls get creative and create a mini set. Have girls take turns playing different roles and you can split the story up into two parts, one on deciding what game to play and the other on what to do with the gift of cheese. Your girls can even create their own story inspired by Lupe!

Step 3: Practice being honest and fair

Play a game like musical chairs, red light green light or freeze dance. Remind the girls of Lupe's story and how a game is meant to be fun. You can even come up with fun roles for girls when they are out of the game. Some examples include being the caller in red light green light or being in charge of the music with musical chairs or freeze dance.

Congratulations! You have now earned the Lupe Petal!
