- Ensure that girls are involved in all phases of decision making and program planning.
- Is at least 18 years old
- Is or willing to become a member of Girl Scouts of the USA
- Submit to and pass a criminal background check every three years
- Complete required Girl Scout troop leader trainings online
- Monthly commitment: 10–15 hours
