What is Bridging?

Girls can earn a Bridging Award each time they move to a new level by sharing what they have learned with younger Girl Scouts and connecting with older Girl Scouts to learn more about their new program level. Girls can participate in troop, service unit, and council bridging events.

Rallyhood is the networking platform for Girl Scout members, volunteers, and council staff throughout GSHCC's 18 counties to connect, collaborate, and get things done. We recommend families join the "634 GSHCC Family Connection" rally and their local service unit rally to learn more about upcoming events, share photos, and chat with other Girl Scout families, volunteers, and staff members. Troops may also choose to set up a rally to connect, share meeting information, and send event reminders. The Rallyhood platform combines the functionality of tools like Eventbrite, SignUp Genius, Shutterfly, Facebook, Flickr, Google Calendar, Google Forms, and Survey Monkey all in one place. It seamlessly integrates so many of the functions troops need, including communication, calendars, file sharing, and surveys. Service units and troops can customize their sites with their own photos and information, creating their own space for volunteers and parents to communicate. Financial Assistance





Join in the Girl Scout Senior Fun!

Girl Scout Seniors are ready to take the world by storm—and at Girl Scouts, there are millions of ways to do it!

Make the best of your years as a Girl Scout.

Go on an adventure and **TRAVEL** amazing places like Costa Rica, Japan, India, and more!

Be a positive **ROLE MODEL**, mentor younger girls, develop strong friendships, and fight bullying.

Join with other girls to tackle an important international issue and **EARN** a Global Action award.

EXPLORE exciting careers in a variety of fields—from science to the arts, to education to government.

And, of course, Seniors can earn their **GOLD AWARD**, which adds that "little something extra" to college and scholarship applications!

Mentoring Awards

You can gain leadership experience by sharing skills, testing knowledge, and trying out new roles by mentoring younger girls. For the girls being mentored, it means a chance to be with and learn from teens—some of their favorite people. You can find complete descriptions and requirements for these awards in your Girl's Guide to Girl Scouting.



Counselor-in-Training I (CIT)

Love Camp? Help create those same memories for a new generation of Girl Scouts by earning you're Counselor-in-Training (CIT) award at Resident Camp or Day Camp.



Volunteer-in-Training (VIT)

By earning this award, you'll be able to lead activities in any Girl Scout setting except for at camp. If you've completed ninth grade, you're eligible to earn this award. A VIT project needs to span a three-to-six month period.

Leadership Awards

Earning these awards allows you to learn about yourself and your style and build upon your leadership skills.



Senior Torch Pin

The Torch Pin recognizes girls who act as leaders in their communities. To earn the award, complete one journey at your current grade level and serve one full term in a leadership role at your school, church, library, town council, or in any other community leadership role.



Community Service Bars

The Community Service Bars recognize girls who make a difference within their community, both within and outside of Girl Scouts. You can earn the Community Service bar by providing 20 hours of service to a single organization or earn the Community Service to Girl Scouting bar by providing 20 hours of service to Girl Scouts.



Trainings Open to Older Girls

Ambassadors have the opportunity to participate in trainings to build skills and assist with the earning of mentoring and leadership awards. Trainings are offered virtually and in-person when possible. Most classes are offered at least once a month, we can also set up trainings by request.

Volunteer-in-Training (VIT)

Required to earn the VIT Award prior to developing your VIT project.

First Aid & CPR

Girls who are 12 and older can participate in our certification courses, girls 16 and older can also participate in Wilderness First Aid.

Prepare 2B Ready

This course focuses on risk management and event planning for girls interested in planning their own events.

Take Action Gold Award

This course reviews the steps to earn the Girl Scout Gold Award.



GSHCC Rose Award

This award was created by Girl Scout Seniors in our council with the intent to recognize and promote leadership and learning in several different areas including, but not limited to: values and ethics, service to others, career exploration and independent living skills.



10 Year Pin

Girls who have been a member of Girl Scouts for ten years are eligible to receive their 10 year pin from GSHCC.



Girl Scout Gold Award

The Gold Award is the highest award a Girl Scout can earn. Each girl plans and carries out her own Take Action project focused on an issue that they care about. Girls who earn their Gold Award can apply for council scholarship opportunities.



Join Girl Scouts from across the Movement for weekly episodes that focus on issues girls care about most as well as interviews with incredible Girl Scouts and special guests. Join in on the conversations every week on Thursdays at 7:00pm ET on Girl Scouts' IGTV! At G-Team TV you will find a show packed with ideas, conversations, and influencers that matter to middle and high school girls like you. 
Bridging Kits are great for Girl Scouts flying up to the next level!


